DETAILS OF WORK

We propose to plug and abandon this well as follows:

15 sacks neat cement 9800' - 9650' over present perforations 9742'-9766'

30 sacks neat cement 7950' - 7850'

40 sacks neat cement 5580' - 5470'

75 sacks neat cement 3200' - 3000'

75 sacks neat cement 1650' - 1450'

15 sacks neat cement 1000' - 965' (in and out 9 5/8" casing)

15 sacks neat cement at surface w/marker. Heavy mud will be used between cement plugs.

The following casing will be left in well:

9 5/8" 32.3 lb H-40 casing set at 984' w/320 sacks cement

4 1/2" 11.4 lb N-80 cas. set at 10,000'. (Approx. 9000' will be pulled)

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
