DETAILS OF WORK

We propose to drill this well with rotary tools to an approximate total depth of 5800' unless commercial production is obtained at a lesser depth.

We will run approximately 970' of 8-5/8" O.D. casing and cement with 425 sacks of cement.

A 5 1/2" O.D. production string will be run if production is found. Sufficient cement should be used to tie production string into surface pipe

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
