DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

October 15, 1942 filled with mud from 592 to 529. Set bridges of sand and gravel and put in 5 sacks cement. Filled hole from 529 59 459 with mud. Knocked off 5¹/₂" casing at 390 and pulled same. Filled with mud to 365 and put in sand & gravel and 5 sacks cement. Filled to surface with mud and set regulation marker in 2 sacks cement.
