12/8/1959/ As per out conversation, I pulled tubing and lodged; cleaned hole out to bottom; drilled hole to 480'; run 2" tubing 12/9/1959. Acidized with 3,000 gallon of acid and 250 barrels of water. Put well to pumping at noon 12/9/1959. First 19 hours pumping. Well made 85 barrels of fluid, which was 55 barrels of water and 30 barrels of oil.
