DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Acidized on March 12, using 1000 gallons of acid.

Before acidizing, the well made about 3/4 barrel of fluid, which was about 50% water and 50% oil. After acidizing, during first 24 hours, the well made about 60 barrels of fluid, of which about 50% was water and 50% oil. The present water ratio is gradually decreasing and the well is now producing around 42 barrels of oil in twenty-four hour period.
