DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

After setting and cementing 503 ft. of 5 1/2 inch O.D. 17 lb. casing at depth of 503 ft., cleaned out hole from 503 ft. to 530 ft. and acidized from said 503 ft. to 530 ft., with 2000 gal. of acid, said acidizing work being done by Halliburton Oil Well Cementing Company. Said acidizing work was done on September 29, 1942.

Results of acidizing were as follows:

Before acidizing the natural production was about 1 1/2 bbls per 24 hr. day. After acidizing, first 24 hr. test showed total production of 35 bbls.
