RULE 1112. REQUEST FOR ALLOWABLE (FORM C-104)

It is necessary that this form be submitted by the operators before an initial allowable will be assigned to any completed oil well. C-110 "Certificate of Compliance" will not be approved until C-104 is filed with the Commission. Form C-104 is to be submitted in triplicate to the Commission Office, to which Form C-101 was sent. Two copies will be retained there and the other submitted to the Proration Office, Hobbs, New Mexico. The allowable will be assigned effective 7.00 A.M., on date of completion. The completion date shall be that date in the case of an oil well, when oil is delivered into the stock tanks.
