Run frac without increasing production. Put 15 sacs cement in bottom of pipe and pulled 1800 ft. 5-1/2" - set plug and cemented with 10 sacs, mudded to bottom of surface and cemented w/10 sacs, mudded from there to 30 ft. of surface and cemented marker w/5 sacs.

Cleaned up location
As per conversation with Mr. Evans on February 15, 1959 approval was granted to cement 15 sac cement in bottom for bottom plug. Pulled 1800' and set plug on top of stub and cement with 10 sac. Mudded to bottom of surface with 372' and cement with 10 sac and mud from there to surface. ARTESIA, NEW MEXICO
