Following is a Notice of Intention to do certain work as described below at the Kincaid & Watson

(Company or Operator) Kincaid State Well No. 2 in 0 (Unit)
NE SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Sec. 35, T. 16S, R. 28E, NMPM, Undesignated Pool
(40-acre Subdivision)
Eddy County.

FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

We have drilled a test well at the above location to a total depth of 1641 feet. We encountered surface water at 65 feet and landed 120 feet of 10 3/4" casing. We ran 8 5/8" casing through the salt section landing same at 428 feet. We encountered water in the red sand at 1315 feet and ran 1369 feet of 7" casing to shut off same. We only encountered a very slight show of gas in a sand section (1558-62).

We propose to plug the well as follows: Put cement plugs of 5 sacks each above the gas show at 1558, above the red sand at 1315, and at the base of the salt at 380 feet and a plug of 10 sacks below the surface water at 65 feet.

We will endeavor to pull all casing as we plug the well and will fill all annular space between the cement plugs with mud, cement the cellar, put up a regulation marker and clean up the location.
