Gentlemen:

Our attention has been called to the fact that on the above well we set casing according to a different pattern than called for in the C-101, and through an oversight we failed to file an amended C-101.

We want to apologize for this error and we assure you that it will not happen again.

This was a re-entry of an abandoned well. We had expected to find oil and gas in sufficient quantity to make a commercial well. When we found that we had very little of either we decided to use 2 7/8" O.D. tubing for casing and cement to the surface in order to cut the costs and make it so that with the limited production obtained the well would have a chance of paying out.

We had no intent to by pass the rules and regulations and in the future we will make every effort to fully comply in all respects.

It would be appreciated if you would give us authorization to sell oil and gas from this well.
