Dear Mr. Clote:

This is in reply to your letter of April 14, 1955, with reference to your Randal-State No. 1 well in the SW/NE, Section 4-17S-28E, Eddy County, New Mexico.

It will not be necessary for you to file a corrected Form C-101, Notice of Intention to Drill. As you will note on your approved copy of Form C-101, I have added the name Randal to State. Therefore, you may file all future reports as Randal-State No. 1. You will also note that I have changed your designation from Wildcat to Red Lake Pool, as the location of the well is in the Red Lake Pool boundary as designated by the Commission. However, if the well is dry at total depth and plugged back and completed as a gas well, it will be an extension of the Vandagriff-Keyes Gas Pool.

We would like to have report of beginning drilling operations and also any casing that has been run on Form C-103 in triplicate. I am enclosing some Form C-103's.
