Casing was perforated from 2046' to 2052' with 24 shots and well treated with 200 bbls. of lease crude and 2000# sand - treating pressure 4000#. Perforated casing from 1956' to 1974' and 1984' to 1993' with 4 shots per foot. Treated through perforations with 300 bbls. lease oil and 17,000# sand. Treating pressure 2650#. Dropped 20 rubber balls and treated with 300 bbls. lease oil and 17,000# sand. Treating pressure 3600#. After recovering load oil, well flowed 84 barrels of oil first 24 hours. Choke 3/8" - casing pressure 240#.
