NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ABANDON WELL

Notice must be given at least five days before work is to begin to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the plugging of wells being abandoned whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to the sender. Submit this notice in duplicate. Following the completion of the plugging a report should be made under "Report on Result of Abandonment of Well" on Form SG-106.

Fill with mud and cement & wood plug covered with cement will be placed 1665' where the hole was reduced, mud will be run in from there to within 15' of the top, cement will be run in the balance of the way.
