NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ABANDON WELL

Notice must be given at least five days before work is to begin to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the plugging of wells being abandoned whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to the sender. Submit this notice in duplicate. Following the completion of the plugging a report should be made under "Report on Result of Abandonment of Well" on Form SG-106.

Dear Sir:

You are hereby notified that it is our intention to abandon Hammond-Etz-Keyes Well
No. 1 in SE 1/4 of Sec. 16 T. 17, R. 28,
N. M. P. M., Artesia Oil Field, Eddy County.
We plan to commence work on April 5, 1936.

The reasons for wishing to abandon the well are as follows:

No production

The present condition of the well is as follows:

1664' 6 5/8 pipe in hole.

The work which we propose to do in abandoning the well is as follows:

Fill up to 1930 with mud,
set cement plug at 1930, fill up with mud to 1229, cement
plug to 1198, fill up with mud to 440, cement plug to 430,
mud from there to top of ground where a cement crown with
a 4" pipe will be placed.
