The elevation of the derrick floor above sea level is 3660 ft.

DETAILS OF PLAN OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work.)

The 8 1/2 inch casing in this hole was found to be cemented from shoe to surface and could not be pulled. The hole was completely filled from bottom to surface with loose earth. A marker of 10 feet of 4-inch pipe extending 4 feet under the surface and 6 feet above ground was set with 3 sacks of cement. The top of the marker was filled with a cement cap.

Work on the lease was started May 16, 1932; actual plugging of this particular well was started May 22, 1932 and completed May 26, 1932.

Government contract number is I-gs 1624. Plugging inspected by Roswell office on June 2, 1932.
