This well was drilled to a total depth of 3310 feet. Did not show for any production below premier pay at a depth of 1890 feet to 1910 feet. We set a permanent Halliburton bridge plug at 2000 feet, cemented on top of it up to 1973.

We propose to abandon and pull pipe from said well after setting a cement bridge plug in the bottom of well and another cement bridge plug where the pipe separates and another cement bridge plug in top of well and set marker.

We will start operations on this well about the fifth day of October, 1965.

Instructions
