It is the intention to plug this hole back from its total depth of 1867' to 1825', there set 10 sacks of cement, plug back with mud to above the bottom of the 7" casing which is set at 1597', and set 2 sacks of cement at about 1585', plug back with mud to above the bottom of the 8" casing which is set at 414', and set 5 sacks of cement, plug back to the surface with mud and set regulation marker in 5 sacks of cement. This is in accordance with our conversation today.
