FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

The above well was plugged in the following manner:

8" Casing was set at 595';
7" Casing was cemented @ 1748' with 25 sacks of cement;
Hole was filled with heavy mud from total depth of 2075' and
a plugged back depth of 2031' to 1970'; cement plug set at
1970'; knocked off and pulled 7" casing; filled with heavy
mud to 600' and pulled 8" casing; filled with mud to 375'
and set cement plug; filled with mud to 100' and set a
cement plug; filled to surface with heavy mud and set a
regulation 4' marker in cement.

Work commenced November 21, 1947 and completed November 25, 1947.
Form C-103 was not submitted by the operator. This report
submitted February 6, 1953.
