The above well was originally scheduled to test the Seven Rivers. It was drilled at 845 to 850' and tested 8 gals. per hour on bailing test. We have been granted the right to test the Premier Sand so are continuing drilling operations. This section is expected at 2150-2200'. Should this section look to be more productive than the Seven Rivers we propose to set 4 1/2" OD Casing and cement with 50 sx. cement. After which well would be perforated and fraced.
