We requested that the operator file the attached subject form C-123 in order to transfer certain acreage from the Red Lake (Grayburg-San Andres) Pool to the Artesia (Queen-Grayburg-San Andres) Pool. This transfer is necessitated by the fact that they have found oil in the Queen formation in their No. 2 Well and are attempting a Queen completion in their No. 4 Well.

I have made a plat showing the proposed change. You will note that this area is adjacent to that half-section already on for transfer at this month's hearing. Therefore, could you please bring this transfer of acreage before the Commission at the same hearing.
