Dear Madam:

We refer to your letter of February 7 in which you ask for information on the Blake State No. 1 well, SE/4 SE/4 Sect. 30, Twp. 17 South, Rge. 28 East, Eddy County, New Mexico.

According to our reports, the well has not been plugged and abandoned, but is now being worked over.

When a well is plugged, the operator plugs it in accordance with requirements of the Oil Conservation Commission. The plugging must be finally approved by an inspector of the Commission before the operator is released from his plugging responsibilities as set forth in the surety bond required of all operators who drill on state or privately owned land.

We are forwarding copy of this letter to our oil and gas inspector in whose district Eddy County lies. If you desire later information on this well, you may contact him directly.
