FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

On June 20, 1942, plan to abandon well. The well has 399' of 8 1/4" casing, of which we plan to recover as much as possible. After pulling pipe, well will be cleaned out and cement plug ran on bottom, well will be mudded from 527' to 524' where another 10 sack cement plug will be run. Will then mud well from 520' to 400' another 10 sack cement plug will mud well from 400' to 385' another 10 sack cement plug will then mud well to top of hole where another 10 sack plug will be run and a four inch pipe left protruding four feet above the ground.

FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK
FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

On June 20, 1945, plan to abandon well. The well is 20' deep, of 2 1/4" casing, of which we plan to recover as much as possible. After pulling pipe, well will be cemented out to surface and another on bottom, will be mudded from 227' to 216' where another 10' each cement plug will be run. Will then mud well from 220' to 100', another 10' each cement plug will mud well from 100' to 227'. Another 10' each cement plug will then mud well to top of hole where another 10' each plug will be run and a four inch pipe 12' protruding four feet above the ground.
