On about May 23, 1946 plan to cement 8" used Lapweld casing at 975' with 50 sacks cement using Halliburton Oil Well Cementing Equipment.

The total depth of this well is 2254'. We plan to set a bridge at 1000' and cement the above casing; after waiting 72 hours for cement to set plan to drill plug remove bridge and complete as a gas well.
