DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On Oct. 14, 1953 set 1423' of 2" tubing, pumped hole full of mud, pumped 10 sacks cement to 1423'. Pulled tubing. On Oct. 15, 1953 pulled 72 pipe, run 915' of tubing, pumped 10 sacks cement to 915', pulled tubing. On Oct. 16, 1953 bridge hole at 700' back to 690', dumped three sacks Calseal, filled hole to 678, dumped 10 sacks cement. On Oct. 17, 1953 found top of cement 643, dumped 3 sacks Calseal, filled to 629. Oct. 19, 1953 bailed hole dry to 629, water and gas cut off. Hole dry. Perforated 8 5/8" pipe with 23 shots from 610 to 615. Oct. 20, 1953 run tubing, acidized with 1,000 gals. Oct. 21, 1953 run rods, started pumping out acid water plus 4 bbls. oil. Oct. 22, 1953 pump well on machine 6 hrs., pumped 16 bbls. of oil.
