## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

7-19-52 Run tubing to 1795' Pumped Hole Full of Mud, killed gas, pumped 5 sacks cement to 1795' pulled tubing back to 1415', pumped 10 sacks cement to 1415', pulled out tubing 7-20-52. Pulled 7" pipe run 875' 2" tubing, pumped 10 sacks cement to 875' pulled tubing.  
 7-26-52 Cleaned out hole to 645' dumped 3 sacks cal-seal. 7-27-52 Cleaned out to 636', tested hole, water, gas etc., shut off. O. K. below 636' shallow pay tested 1 bbl oil per day.  
 8-6-52 acidized with one thousand gal. acid through 2" tubing and straddle packer from 602' to 611' and 1000 gal acid from 621' to 630'. No results from acid shallow pay still tested one barrel per day.  
 Aug. 27-52 Filled hole with mud to 590' dumped 5 sacks cement. Started 8" pipe.  
 Aug. 28-52 Pulled 8" filled hole with mud.  
 Sept. 1-52 Plugging completed.  
 Oct. 30-52 Pits leveled up and set 4" Marker in cement.
