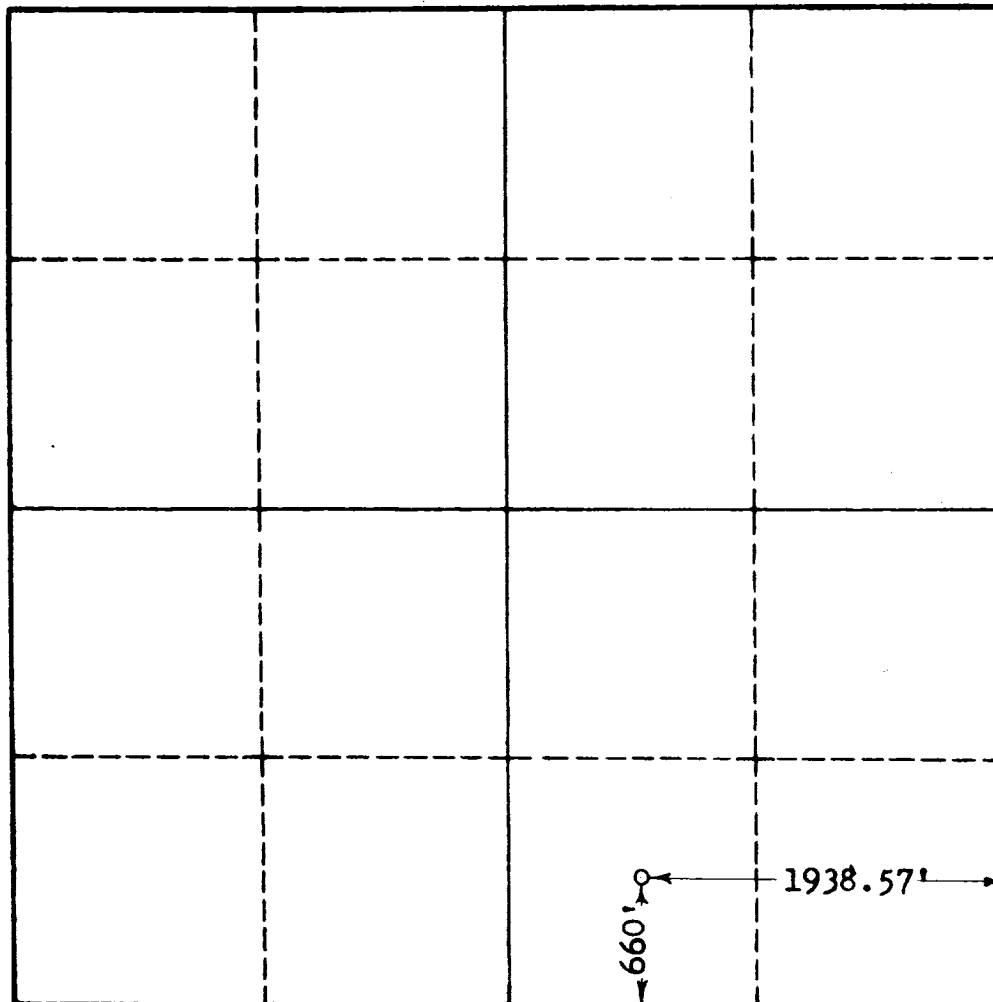


Gentlemen:

On January 16, 1960 a survey was made to locate your No. 1 location on the State "BJ" lease at a point 1938.57 feet from the East line and 660 feet from the South line of Section 31, Township 17 South, Range 28 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, N. M. (this location is also described as follows: 660 feet from the South and 660 feet from the West lines of the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Sec. 31.)

A flag was set on the USGLO Section corner marker common to Sections 31, 32, 5 and 6, and the Transit was set up at the USGLO Quarter corner marker common to Sections 31 and 6. Thence chaining N88° 55'E from the Transit a distance of 660 feet, thence N0° 37'W 660 feet to the location site of the State "BJ" No. 1. As a check on our survey we chained N88° 55'E from the location site a distance of 1938.57 feet to the East line of Section 31, thence S0° 37'E 660 feet to the Section corner common to Sections 31, 32, 5 and 6, checking in within the allowable error for this survey.
