Total depth 3351' - over 2000' of fluid in the hole. Will run approximately 2000' of 8" pipe - set on 8" shoulder where hole was reduced to 6", then will test for pay. Should it be necessary will bridge back, if there is any water below. Will not know until 8" string is set. Will report results on Form C-103. We will shoot and acidize, or acidize and shoot at best pay we encounter.
