Would like permission to pull this pipe, plugging to be done as follows: Bridge back to , or plug back to 2200 ft. cement bottom plug back to 530 ft. cement again, plug back 100 ft. cement again and cement top of hole where top plug is set. The plugging will be done with the mud that came out of the hole. Mud is in good condition to plug with. When work is completed will report on form 103.
