DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

After shot was made we let it set forty eight hours then went in to clean out - after a short time bailing, it blew out and apparently cleaned itself and died down. We later went back in and bailed off of bottom. It was dry of water - we then ran tubing and rods to 2200 ft. leaving a 38 ft. rat hole below - began pumping on Oct. 11, and have pumped part time testing and think, when finished, should make 40 barrells or better a day. Gravity 36.
