

MARCH 25, 1960, A SURVEY WAS MADE TO STAKE THE LOCATION FOR YOUR STATE "BQ" #1 AT A POINT 1947.25 FEET FROM THE WEST AND 1943.90 FEET FROM THE SOUTH LINE OF SEC. 34, TWP. 17S, RGE. 28E N.M.P.M. EDDY COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

THE SURVEY WAS STARTED AT THE SOUTH QUARTER CORNER OF SECTION 34, THENCE $88^{\circ}55'W$ 657.18 FEET ALONG THE SOUTH LINE OF SECTION 34, THENCE $N0^{\circ}42'W$ 1943.90 FEET TO THE LOCATION. WE THEN CHAINED $N88^{\circ}55'W$ 1947.25 FEET, THENCE $S0^{\circ}42'E$ 1943.9 FEET AND CHECKED WITHIN 0.8 FEET OF THE MARKER ON THE SOUTH-WEST CORNER OF SECTION 34. THIS CHECK IS WITHIN THE ALLOWABLE LIMITS OF THIS SURVEY.
