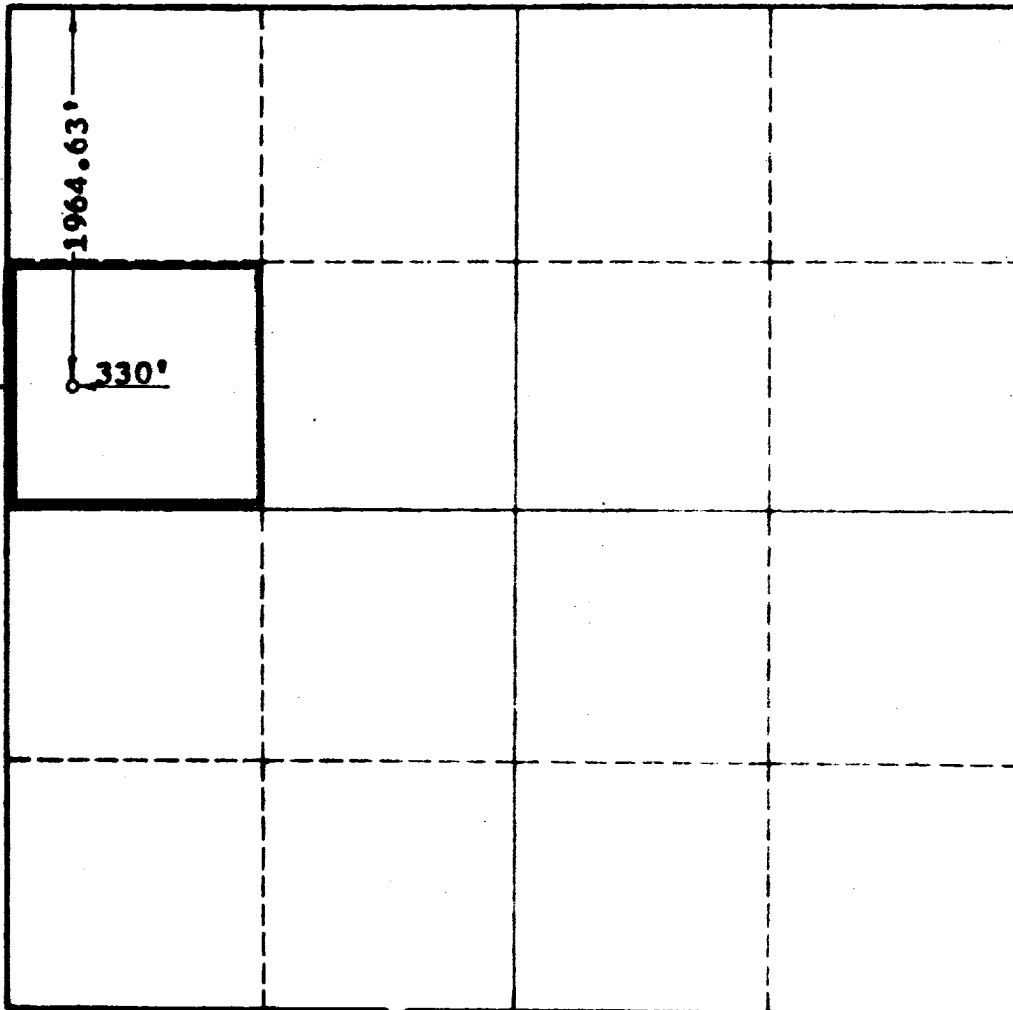


Gentlemen:

On April 9, 1960, a survey was made to stake the location of your State "BU" No. 1 well at a point 330 feet from the West line and 1964.63 feet from the North line of Section 34, Twp. 17 South, Rng. 28 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico.

The transit was placed over the USGLO marker set for the Northwest corner of said Section 34, taking a foresight on a flag set at the USGLO marker set for the West Quarter Section corner of said Section 34. Thence chaining along the West boundary line of said Section 34, $80^{\circ} 42' E$ a distance of 1964.63 feet setting a hub with a tack. Thence chaining $N89^{\circ} 23' E$ from said hub a distance of 330 feet to the location. As a check on our survey we chained $S89^{\circ} 23' W$ a distance of 330 feet and $80^{\circ} 42' E$ a distance of 647 feet, closing within 0.31 feet of the distance shown on the USGLO Township Plats.
