Due to the amount of water found in the shallow sands causing a cavey hole, it was necessary to run 10" casing in this hole. It was set and mudded at a depth of 315'. After allowing to set for sufficient time for the mud to settle, the hole was bailed dry and tested. As no water appeared, drilling was resumed.
