Gentlemen:

In December 1960 we completed our Sinclair State well in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 35, T. 17 S., R. 28 E., Artesia Field, Eddy County, New Mexico. This well is producing from the San Andres formation between a depth of 2852 feet and 2868 feet below the surface. This well is on the same 40 acre proration unit as a well belonging to Donnelly Drilling Company which is producing from the Grayburg formation at a shallower depth.

We were granted a testing allowable for a period of 90 days commencing January 1, 1961. During January we were unable to produce the well because of no pipeline connection. February this well produced 549 barrels for the last 15 days. March it produced 573 barrels in 31 days. A pump was installed on said well this month and the well is currently producing approximately 26 barrels of oil per day.

You are requested to currently grant us monthly the excess allowable over and above that allowable the Donnelly Drilling Company well on this unit is capable of producing.

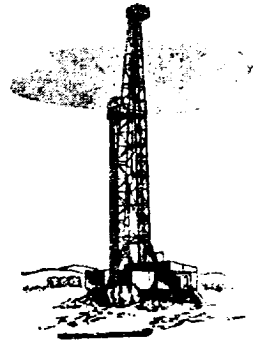
