DETAILS OF WORK

PROPOSED TO PLAN AND ABANDON AS FOLLOWS:

Cement plug of 20 sax from T.O. 3521' to 3457'.

Heavy mud from 3457' to 1600'.

Cement plug of 10 sax from 1600' to 1580'.

Heavy mud from 1580' to 300'.

Cement plug of 10 sax from 300' to 280'.

Fill with heavy mud to surface and erect regulation marker.

We will recover all 8 5/8" OD casing and will leave all 10 3/4" OD casing in hole.

The above program is essentially the same as that outlined in telephone conversation between H. J. Heard and J. A. Frost.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
