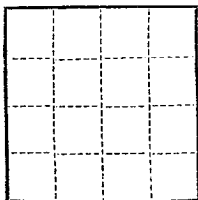

 Cement plug of 10 sacks from 300' to 280';
 Heavy mud from 280' to surface;
 Erected regulation marker.

NOTE: All 8 5/8" casing recovered from hole, 10 3/4" casing, cemented at 355' left in hole.
