

## DETAILS OF WORK

On September 1, 1959, we ran 2075' of 7" OD 8rd thrd 23# used JS casing to 2077' and cemented with 150 sacks neat cement.

After standing cemented 72 hours we pressured up on casing to 3000 psig. We then drilled plug bailed hole down and re-ran bailer. As shut-off proved complete drilling was resumed.

Cementing and pressure testing was done by Denton Oil Well Cementing Co.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
