DETAILS OF WORK

On December 16, 1959, we ran 2097' of 7" OD 8rd thrd 23# used JS casing to 2098' and cemented with 150 sacks cement.

After standing 48 hours we pressured up on casing to 3000 psig.

After standing 72 hours, we drilled plug, bailed hole down and re-ran bailer. As shut-off proved complete, drilling was resumed.

After fracturing well, we pulled 10 3/4" casing loose and spotted 50 sacks cement from 415' to 312'.

Cementing and pressure testing done by Denton Oil Well Cementing Company.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
