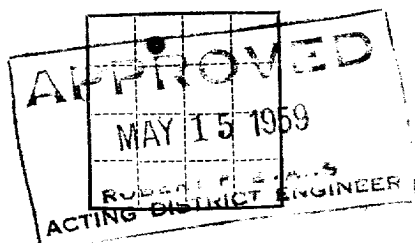

DETAILS OF WORK

On May 4, 1959, we ran 2065' (66 Joints) of 7" OD 8rd thrd 23# used JS casing to 2160' and cemented with 150 sacks cement.

After standing cemented 72 hours we pressured up on casing to 3000 psig. We then bailed hole dry, drilled plug and re-ran bailer.

As shut-off proved complete drilling operations were resumed.

Cementing and pressure testing was done by Denton Oil Well Cementing Company.
