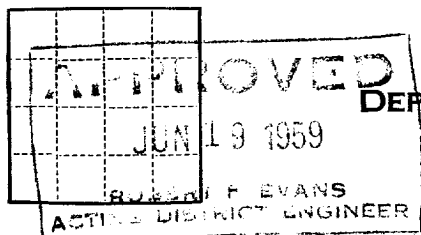

DETAILS OF WORK

On June 12, 1959 we ran 2103' of 7" 80 8rd thrd 23# used JS casing to 2106' and cemented with 150 sacks neat cement.

After standing cemented for 72 hours we pressured up on casing to 3000 psig. We then drilled plug, bailed hole down and re-ran tailer. As shut-off proved complete drilling was resumed.

Cementing and pressure testing was done by Denton Oil Well Cementing Company.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
