Please be advised that the following wells are now in compliance with BLM stipulations:

(LC-061638) E. Hi Lonesome Fed #7, Eddy County, Sec. 13, Township 16S, Range 29E - drill pad and 700' of access road has been ripped and reseeded according to BLM recommendations, and have been protected from vehicular travel. The well sign has been removed.

(LC-061638) E. Hi Lonesome Fed #26, Eddy County, Sec. 12, Township 16S, Range 29E - drill pad has been ripped and the drill site has been reseeded according to BLM recommendations.

(LC-061638) E. Hi Lonesome Fed #10, Eddy County, Sec. 13, Township 16S, Range 29E - drill pad and 1/2 mile of access road has been ripped and reseeded according to BLM recommendations, and protected from vehicular travel. The 1/4 mile of road from E. Hi Lonesome #7 to #10 and the 1/4 mile of road from #10 has been ripped, reseeded and protected from vehicular travel.

(NM-04068) Sivley Fed #7, Eddy County, Sec. 17, Township 16S, Range 30E - drill pad and .15 miles of access road has been ripped, recontoured per special stipulations, reseeded and protected from vehicular travel. The well sign and power pole have been removed.
