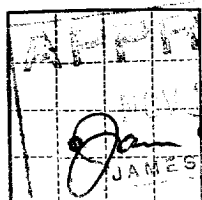

DETAILS OF WORK

On November 7, 1959 we ran 2119' of 7" OD 8rd thrd LT & C 23# used JS casing to 2122' and cemented with 150 sacks cement.

After standing cemented for 72 hours, we pressured upon casing to 3000 psig. We then drilled plug, bailed hole down and re-ran bailer. As shut-off proved complete, drilling was resumed.

After fracturing well, we pulled 10 3/4" casing loose and spotted 50 sacks cement from 420' to 310'.

Cementing and pressure testing was done by Denton Oil Well Cementing Company.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
