## DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

On December 14, 1959 we ran 2027' of 7" OD 8rd thrd 23# used JS casing to 2029' and cemented with 150 sacks cement.

After standing 48 hours we pressured up on casing to 3000 psig. After standing 72 hours we drilled plug, bailed hole down and re-ran bailer. As shut-off proved complete, drilling was resumed.

After fracturing well, we pulled 10 3/4" casing loose and spotted 50 sacks cement from 364' to 261'.

Cementing and pressure testing was done by Denton Oil Well Cementing Company.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
