Dear Mr. Wigzell:

I am in receipt of a letter addressed to Bob Pike dated March 7, 1961, in which you requested production reports on the two McAllister wells you recently purchased. The following production records are taken from operators monthly reports starting in June 1960.

Enclosing The reports for December of 1960, and January of 1961, have been delayed due to loss of a run ticket. The USGS has been informed of this delay, and these papers will be filed this week. The production for February has not been filed this date, but I am estimating that the production for these three months will be approximately 142 barrels per month. A memorandum in regards to the location of tank batteries on form C-110, two copies of certificate of compliance and authorization to transport Oil and Natural Gas. I am assuming that Castle and Wigzell, operators of the McAllister lease will file the proper forms in March, 1961, in relation to all production.

Mrs. Blanche McAllister has been contacted in regards to the Designation of Operator, and I should have these forms no later than the first of next week.
