In reference to your April 14 letter, if we change the bond to include the Falls Equipment Company, of Wichita Falls, they would then be involved in all of your operations - which I do not feel would be practical.

I discussed the situation with Mr. Bob Hanson, of the Oil Conservation Commission, and we both feel that the simplest way to handle would be to re-file the Form C110 in the name of J. C. Clower. By handling in this manner, it would not affect any working interest.

With this thought in mind, we are enclosing five (5) copies of the C110 form. The original and three copies are to be filed with the Oil Conservation Commission. If you will complete and return to my office I will file for you.

Mr. Hanson advised that you had in your office the original Form C110 that was filed "J. C. Clower, et al".
