
Pursuant to the letter of July 30, 1987 regarding temporary abandoned status of the referenced wells and testing the down hole equipment/casing, we request that these tests not be performed. The Simmons Fed. #3 & Simmons Fed. #5 are shut in gas wells which are open-ended tubing completions. In order to test these wells, it would be necessary to "kill" the wells. It has been our experience that the wells are sensitive to formation damage from water and should not be killed. These wells are capable of producing, but due to the present economic situation, no gas contracts have been obtained, therefore, the wells remain shut-in. The Simmons Fed. #2 is a producing oil well capable of producing, but has had production suspended per the BLM order of 1986. Since it is not the only well on the lease capable of production, no suspension was approved. In view of this, we request that the proposed tests be cancelled on the Simmons #3 & #5 and postponed on the Simmons #2 until the well is placed in temporary abandoned status.
