Hole shot with 130 quarts of nitro-glycerine (amount required to cover pay section) on February second 1940. at 6:30 P.M.

At eight o'clock February third 1940 there was 1050 feet of oil in the hole. On February fourth at eight (A.M.) there was 1400 feet of oil in the hole.

Have run tubing and rods (2" with five-eighths rods) and will test well February sixth and seventh if possible.

Hole is cleaned to 2155. There is no water in hole.
