DETAILS OF WORK

A. The work proposed to do in checking zone from 1260 to 1265 ft. ✓
Acid was swabbed back through 2 in. tubing with no result in production of oil. Well is shut in for future water flood purposes.

Hole was loaded with water. Squeezed 5" casing with 50 sacks of cement thru perforation at 1294 leaving cement bridge in casing. Perforated casing from 12'2"-12'6" with eight 1/2-inch holes. Acidized perforations with 500 gallons of acid. Did not encounter commercial oil. Temporarily abandoned well by capping well. Seven Rivers zone is isolated from San Andres zone by cement bridge.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
