FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK  
(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

Total depth 2636'; 8 5/8" @ 497' W/50 sacks; 5 1/2" @ 2612' W/100 sacks.

Cumulative production thru 5 -31-62: 13,069 barrels oil.

Average daily production May, 1962: 0.2 BOPD

We propose to convert the above well to water injection as follows:

Pull tubing and clean out to total depth.

Run approximately 2570' of 2 3/8" OD EUE plastic coated tubing with hookwall packer and hydraulic anchor on bottom.

Load annulus with crude oil treated with corrosion inhibitor.

Injection volume will be approximately 100 BWPD.

Pressured water for injection will be delivered to above lease by Neil A. Salsich.
