Dear Mr. Mills:

We are in receipt of Form C-127 requesting an allowable of 2 barrels per day for the subject well. However, before the allowable may be assigned, certain reports must be filed as follows: Form C-103 showing the work done in returning the well to production from its temporarily abandoned status; if the oil now goes to the consolidated tank battery, Form C-104 must be filed showing a change in oil transporter, addition of gas transporter and change in tank battery location.

Further, a review of our files for other wells in the West Henshaw Premier Unit reveals that Form C-104s, showing the change in tank battery location to the consolidated battery site, have not been filed. If you will verify that all wells in the unit produce to the consolidated battery, we will note the change.
