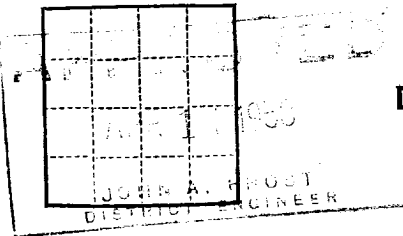

DETAILS OF WORK

On April 2, 1958, we ran 2845.41' (88 joints 2 1/2") of 7" OD 8rd. thrd. 23# new JS Casing to 2848' and cemented with 100 sacks neat cement, preceded by 75 Bbls. Aquagel.

After allowing to stand cemented for 72 hours, we drilled plug, bailed Hole down, and re-ran bailer.

As shut-off proved complete, drilling was resumed.

Cementing was done by Denton Oil Well Cementing Co.
